Dear Secretary Salas:

On August 8, 2006 the Swinomish Indian Tribal Community filed motions to intervene in four Snohomish County PUD No. 1 tidal hydroelectric projects P-12689 Spieden Channel, P-12690 Admiralty Inlet, P-12692 San Juan Channel, and P-12698 Guemes Channel.

The FERC notices for these motions to intervene list the filer as the Swinomish Indian Tribal Community and the agent as the Sauk-Suiattle Indian Tribe. Each Tribe is a separate sauvignon nation. The Swinomish Indian Tribal Community is a federally recognized Indian Tribe and acts as its own agent. The Sauk-Suiattle Indian Tribe does not represent the Swinomish Indian Tribal Community. Please correct your records to show the Swinomish Indian Tribal Community as acting as its own agent for these projects.
