Dear Mr. Timmons:

This is in reference to your preliminary permit application filed September 20, 2006, for the Admiralty Inlet Tidal Energy Project. In your application, you proposed to study developing a project at this location, using hydrokinetic technologies to generate electricity from tidal currents. The description of the project location, technology and equipment is very general.

We are requesting that you file additional information that more narrowly and specifically describes the technology/equipment you intend to use at the project. Further, we are requesting that you reduce the area within the project boundary to more realistically represent the actual footprint of your proposed tidal project.

Your response should be filed with the Commission within 7 days of the date of this letter. You should include appropriate descriptions, diagrams, and maps to clarify your proposals.


