Subject: Additional Information Request Preliminary Permit Applications

Dear Mr. Cannon:

In order for staff to further process the applications of the Tidal Energy Companies (TECs) for the Deception Pass, Columbia, Kachemak Bay, Icy Passage, Gastineau Channel, and Wrangell Narrows Tidal Energy Hydroelectric Projects, the applicant must provide the following information:

- (1) The articles of organization for each TEC.
- (2) A list of names and titles of the officers and members of each TEC.
- (3) A copy of the state-issued certifications showing the date each TEC was officially recognized in the state it was created.
- (4) A state-issued certification showing that each TEC is still in existence and in good standing.
- (5) A description of any affiliated parent company, the names and addresses of its agents, and its articles of organization, since the TECs possess identical mailing addresses and phone numbers.
- (6) A description of the corporate strategy in developing the number of applications for tidal energy projects.



(7) A description of any business or other relationships between the TECs and any profit and non-profit organizations.

(8) A detailed plan on how the TECs propos to raise the money to fund the studies and possibly, the project itself.
